Annex 1(b) Product Scope Exclusions

This Arrangement does not cover the following products:

- Aquaculture products, including algae and other aquatic plants or plant-like species;
- Apiculture products;
- Wild harvested products.

Annex 1(c) Organic Ingredients in Processed Foods

The end products of organic processed products exported from one Participant to the other will be certified within the exporting Participant's domestic territory and comprise of at least 95% ingredients that have been processed and certified in accordance with either:

- the MPI Official Organic Assurance Programme Technical Rules of Production by a *Third Party Agency* directly recognised by MPI; or
- the TPKM Organic Agriculture Promotion Act and its derived regulations by a *Certification Body* accredited by an accreditation body approved by COA; or
- the organic product certification system of a country or member of the World Trade Organisation (WTO) that is in organic equivalence with both New Zealand and the TPKM, given that the certification activities on the concerned materials are performed within the territory of that country or WTO member.
